Re: Accompanying Child Participant into Joe Thornton Community Centre

To Parents/Caregivers/Legal Age Guardian:

Please be advised that effective October 16, 2020 we will be permitting 1 parent/caregiver/legal aged guardian per household into the Joe Thornton Community Centre to accompany youth participants 7 years old and younger. If you plan on attending with a child, it must be pre-arranged through the organization your child plays for ahead of time. There is a maximum of 20 viewers only per established time (no exceptions).

Restrictions surrounding the operations inside the Centre have been based on Provincial guidelines and recommendations from the Health Unit in order to ensure continued public and staff safety.

The following guidelines must be adhered to upon entering the facility:

- Complete the Covid self-assessment each time before entering the facility
- Follow the City's Return to Play Protocol
- Must be wearing a face mask
- Must sanitize hands up on entering
- No entry into the dressing room
- No wandering throughout the arena/facility
- Must sit in the assigned seats indicated for viewing
- If you are feeling ill or have experienced flu like symptoms or have travelled outside of the Country please do not enter the facility for 14 days
